Equipment Notes:

1. **Open** shooters may use any arrow except wooden arrows.
2. **Traditional** shooters must use wooden arrows.
3. Longbow string can not touch limbs other than the tips.
4. Longbow shooters must shoot with one finger touching arrow.
5. Longbow classes include flatbows.
6. No sights, stabilizers, release aids, or string walking.
7. Selfbow All natural material only with Wooden Arrows

- Fifty high-quality 3D targets per round.
- Practice range will be open for warm up.
- Participants may shoot up to 4 rounds, but can only shoot once per class.
- Texas walk-up start in groups of 4 to 6, starting at 7 am.
- No Rangefinders, Binoculars, or Stabilizers
- Double Score Cards Scoring will be in effect
- Minimum Group of Three Shooters per group

Trophies will be awarded to the shooter with the highest combined score for all four main competitive classes.

Participants must shoot one round in each of the following four classes (Men's & Women's):

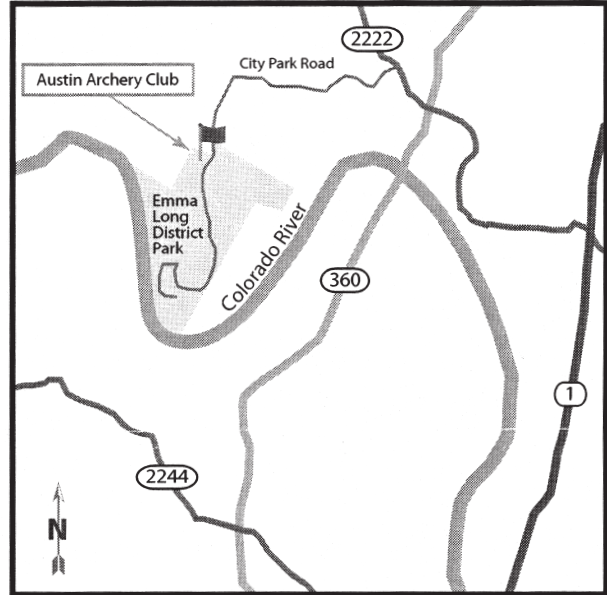
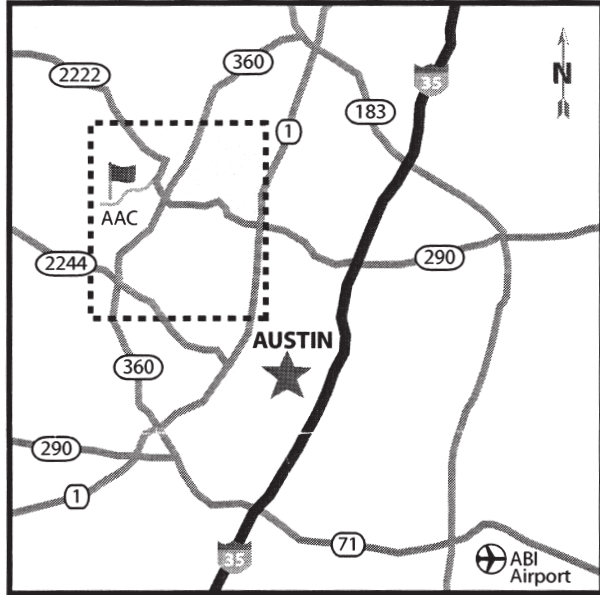
